• Who are Partners in Care?

Partners in Care is a not-for-profit membership organisation representing approximately 260 independent Nursing, Residential, Supported Living and Domiciliary Care providers in Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin.

What do Partners in Care do?

We offer a wide range of services for adult social care providers across Shropshire, Telford & Wrekin. These include training, a Disclosure and Barring Service and a wide range of workforce initiatives.

Why should I become a member of Partners in Care?

You will receive access to benefits including subsidised training courses, subsidised Disclosure and Barring Service, accurate, relevant, and up to date information and advice as well as opportunity to network with your peers.

What training do you offer?

We have a core training offer which includes First Aid, Moving & Handling, Safeguarding Adults Awareness and Professional Boundaries. However, we run many other courses on a regular basis including the Mental Capacity Act (MCA) and Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards (DoLS), Dementia, Medication, PEG, Phlebotomy, Urinary Tract Infection (UTI) Prevention & Management and Clinical Observation. Can I get my Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) check through Partners in Care?

Yes, if you are employed rather than self-employed. We offer a DBS service to our members at a subsidised rate, which is all completed online. Your employer will be able to check your ID as part of the application process, or where necessary this can be done by a member of our team.
