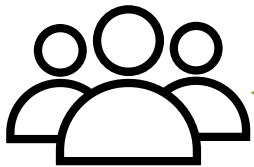

We also lobby local authorities on their annual fee rate uplifts, using insight gained from our members on the financial challenges and the impact of fee rates. This includes an annual Fee Survey undertaken each Autumn, the results of which inform a formal submission to the local authorities setting out what fee rate uplift we believe our members need to cover the cost of the care they provide.

Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) Checks

Partners in Care is a Registered Umbrella Organisation with the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). We process Enhanced and Standard DBS Applications, DBS Adult First Checks, and applications for Volunteers.

Our DBS service is available to members at a discounted rate.

We also share updates and information we are given by the DBS, via our website and direct email alerts.



Throughout the year, we endeavour to access information issued by the DBS and share this information with our members.
